African Asylum Seekers & Refugees in Israel: A Conversation with Oded Oron and Yikealo Beyene Saturday, 3/10 from 1:15pm in the Beit Midrash

Oded Oron is a Ph.D. candidate at UW, with research
focusing on the mobilization of irregular migrants such as
guest workers, undocumented migrants, asylum seekers
and refugees.

Yikealo Beyene, originally from Eritrea, spent two years
in an Ethiopian refugee camp, where he volunteered for
the International Rescue Committee (IRC). As a refugee
in Israel for eight years, he graduated high school, won a
national prize for outstanding students, & pursued his

Hamza Mahmood Zafer is the Assistant Professor of Near Eastern Languages and Civilization at the UW. His research focuses on the Quran's polemical engagements with Jewish communities in Arabia and the portrayal of these communities in the earliest Muslim historical and exegetical writings up to the 9th century.
