**African Asylum Seekers & Refugees in Israel:
A Conversation with Oded Oron and Yikealo Beyene

Oded Oron is a Ph.D. candidate at UW, with research focusing on the mobilization of irregular migrants such as guest workers, undocumented migrants, asylum seekers and refugees.

Yikealo Beyene, originally from Eritrea, spent two years in an Ethiopian refugee camp, where he volunteered for the International Rescue Committee (IRC). As a refugee in Israel for eight years, he graduated high school, won a national prize for outstanding students, & pursued his education in Israel despite enormous legal and financial obstacles.
