Update from our Southern Border - First Hand Reflections with Rabbi Borodin July 7th, from 1:15pm in the Beit Midrash

I am travelling with **T'ruah** - an organization dedicated to the rabbinic call for human rights, as part of a rabbinic mission to San Diego on July 2nd and 3rd.

We will be joining a large mobilization and action call hosted by **Mijente** on July 2nd called **FreeOurFuture** to try to stop Operation Streamline coming to California. Operation Streamline is a mass fast-track prosecution program which moves migrants through in group hearings with no opportunity to share their individual cases and the dangers they face, to arrive at faster deportations. It is already in operation in Arizona and

Texas but has not yet started in California and a multi-organization and multi-faith effort is being launched to stop it from coming to California. On July 3rd, we will be spending the day with **HIAS**, including crossing the border to Mexico with a chance to meet asylum seekers and see first hand some of the conditions they are facing as they attempt to cross the American Mexican border.

I plan to share about my experience after shul on July 7th, and will be posting about it on the Beth Shalom Facebook page and to the CBS immigration-and-sanctuary-beth-shalom-seattle google group. Contact Kayla Weiner if you want to be added to this group, at activistkmw@yahoo.com.
